High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) minimum 2010 deductible \$1,200 for single coverage and \$2,400 for family coverage (increased from \$1,200 and \$2,300, respectively). DHP out-of-pocket maximum \$5,950 for single coverage and \$11,900 for family coverage (increased from \$5,800 and \$11,600 respectively). For plan years beginning after 12/31/2006, individuals who are eligible individuals on the first day of the last month of the taxable year (December 1 <sup>st</sup> for most taxpayers) are allowed the full annual contribution (plus catch up contribution, if 55 or older by year end), regardless of the number of months the individual was an eligible individual in the year. For individuals who are no longer eligible individuals as of December 1 <sup>st</sup> each year, both the HSA contribution and catch up contribution apply pro rata based on the number of months of the year a taxpayer is an eligible individual.
